
## Reading

- Read ahead to help with fluency & expression
- Comments on plot, setting & characters in familiar & unfamiliar stories
- Recounts main themes & events
- Comments on structure of the text
- Use commas, question marks & exclamation marks to vary expression
- Read aloud with expression & intonation
- Recognise inverted commas and contractions
- Identify past/present tense
- Use content and index to locate information
- Identify key features of different text types
- Recommend books and give opinions
- Make predictions based on what has already been read
- Make comparisons between texts they have read
- Recognise simple repetitive language in stories and poetry



## Writing

- Write different kinds of sentence: statement, question, exclamation, command
- Use expanded noun phrases to add description & specification
- Write using subordination (when, if, that, because)
- Correct & consistent use of present tense & past tense
- Correct use of verb tenses
- Correct & consistent use of:
  - Capital letters
  - Full stops
  - Question marks
  - Exclamation marks
  - Commas in a list
  - Apostrophe (omission)
- Introduction of inverted commas
- Write under headings
- Evidence of diagonal & horizontal strokes to join handwriting
- Form lowercase letters of the correct size relative to one another
- Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters
- Segmenting spoken words into phonemes and representing these by graphemes, spelling many correctly
- Learning the possessive apostrophe (singular)
- Writing for different purposes



## **Mathematics**

- Compare & order numbers up to 100
- Read & write all numbers to 100 in digits & words
- Say 10 more/less than any number to 100
- Count in multiples of 2, 3 & 5 & 10 from any number up to 100
- Recall & use multiplication & division facts for 2, 5 & 10 tables
- Recall & use +/- facts to 20
- Derive & use related facts to 100
- Recognise PV of any 2-digit number
- Add & subtract:
  - 2-digit nos & ones
  - 2-digit nos & tens
  - 3 1-digit nos
- Recognise & use inverse (+/-)
- Calculate & write multiplication & division calculations using multiplication tables
- Recognise & use inverse (x/÷)
- Recognise, find, name & write 1/3; 1/4; 2/4; 3/4
- Recognise equivalence of simple fractions
- Tell time to five minutes, including quarter past/to
