On Monday, 15th December, KS2 and their families came together at St. Francis Church to share in a special services.

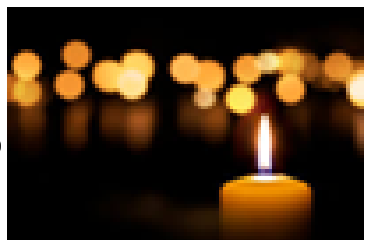
