Korfball After School Club Tuesday Years 1 and 2 and Reception after the October half term

We are pleased to announce that we will be continuing to run our Korfball after school club at Wickham Common in September, but we will now have a day for our younger years. The club will be open to children from Years 1 and 2 and after October half term we will open it for reception children. (Reception children will get a different enrolment letter, at a later date)

The club will run from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the playground. The children will be met at their classrooms by a club coach and taken to a classroom where they can get changed before the session starts. Children will need pe kit and trainers and a water bottle. We will allow children to have a snack if they wish to bring one in before the sessions starts but just a reminder nothing containing nuts please. Please collect your child from the Key stage 1 door by the hall.

The club will run from the 8th September to the 15th December (No classes on the 20th and 27th October due to half term)

For those of you unfamiliar with Korfball in brief it's a mixed team sports where one team tries to outscore their opponents by scoring goals in a basket. What makes Korfball unique is that it was designed to be a mixed team sport, so boys and girls play together from young kids all the up to the national team. It's based on the fundamental principles of teamwork and equality and of course it's a lot of fun!!
